Overview of Changes

- Include more current date values within their respective databases (e.g., sales dates primarily in 2024 instead of 2017).
- Have more consistent formatting and styling of SQL statements throughout content, activities, and data files.
- Have less redundant information presented to the student.
- Incorporate the latest Logical Operations slide template, which has gone through a visual overhaul, and most notably, changed from standard 4:3 format to widescreen 16:9 format.
- Include updates to all figures and activity screenshots.
- Use vector images for non-screenshot images (and image elements) to retain full quality when scaled, and to enable searching of text within figures.
