## Overview of Changes

The following sections describe the substantive changes that have been made to this version of the course.

### Updated content to reflect new certification exam objectives

Since the release of the Second Edition of the *Tableau® Desktop: Part 1* course, Tableau has revised the associated certification exams, retiring the Tableau Desktop Certified Associate exam, revising the Certified Tableau Desktop Specialist exam, and adding the Certified Tableau Data Analyst exam. The Third Edition course aligns with the most recent versions of the Certified Tableau Desktop Specialist and Certified Tableau Data Analyst exams. ### Updated content to reflect UI changes

Tableau has introduced significant changes to the user interfaces of their products since the release of the Second Edition course. The Third Edition course was developed with the most recent releases of Tableau Desktop and Tableau Prep Builder available, and all content has been updated to reflect the changes to the user interfaces, including graphics, slides, procedures, and activities.
